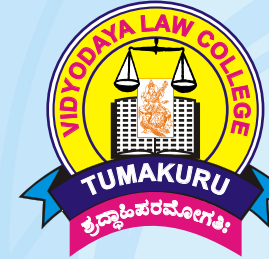

Tumkur District has its own unique feature for being called an education centre. It provides students all courses of education to choose from. This education centre has reached its zenith only when **"VIDYODAYA LAW COLLEGE"** was established under **"VIDYODAYA EDUCATION SOCIETY"** with the sole motto of providing legal education to the students of southern zone of Karnataka in particular and the neighbouring states in general, under the **"Society Registration Act 1860"**, in the year **1958-59**. It is the first college in Karnataka that was founded in the midst of the head quarter and it was affiliated to the Mysore University in 1958-59.

During its affiliation to the Mysore University, there was two years course in existence and the admission was restricted to the graduates under the "Bachelors Degree in Law (B.L.). Later it was converted in to the 3 Years course LL.,B., as per the rules of the Bar Council of India. The same course is being continued even today. The Vidyodaya Education Society got its own campus in the year 1979 with the help of the well known personalities. From 1958-59 to 1993-94, Vidyodaya Law College successfully ran under the supervision and guidance of Vidyodaya Education Society. Later Vidyodaya Education Society has taken a new and innovative shape in the form of **"VIDYODAYA FOUNDATION (R.) TRUST "**.

" SRI VIDYODAYA FOUNDATION (R.) TRUST " was established in the year 1994. Under the guidance of trust, the First Floor and the Second Floor of the building with all infrastructure needed for a Law college was constructed in the heart of the town, in the year 1995 and 2002 respectively. The College has a very wide, spacious and computerized library, good infrastructure and internet with website facilities.



In the year 1974, the Vidyodaya Law College had come under the jurisdiction of the Bangalore University and worked successfully by adhering to the norms of Bangalore University up to 2005. The Vidyodaya Law College also worked under the jurisdiction of Tumkur University from 2005-2009.

Then, the Government of Karnataka was passed a resolution to establish a separate Law University to bring all Law Colleges of Karnataka under its jurisdiction in order to improve standard in legal Education. As a result of this resolution " **THE KARNATAKA STATE LAW UNIVERSITY**" was established in the year 2009,at Hubballi as its head quarter.

Under the guidance and direction of **VIDYODAYA FOUNDATION (R) TRUST**, the Vidyodaya Law College has made a long journey under the Mysore University, Bangalore University and Tumkur University. In this long journey, the college has reached a new peak of development and acquired progressive and innovative changes by successfully chasing all periodical tests and stages under the Mysore University, Bangalore University and Tumkur University.

Now, it has begun a new journey under the "**THE KARNATAKA STATE LAW UNIVERSITY**" from 2009 onwards. We hope that it will achieve and reach a new peak of progress under the jurisdiction of "**KARNATAKA STATE LAW UNIVERSITY**".

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO
B.A., LL.B., 5 YEAR PROGRAMME**

1. The candidate seeking admission to the 5 year LL.B., Programme should have passed the examination in 10+2 Course (P.U.C.) OR J.O.C. (Job-oriented Course) or 3 Yrs. Diploma Course recognized by the Union or by the State Govt, or from any equivalent institution from a foreign country and recognized by the Govt., of that country.
2. Minimum percentage of marks in qualifying examination shall not be below 45% of total marks in case of General Category applicants, 42% of total marks in case of OBC and 40% of total marks in case of SC and ST applicants.

**ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO
LL.B., 3 YEAR PROGRAMME:**

1. The candidate seeking admission to the LL.B. 3 Year Programme should have passed any Degree of a recognized University.
2. Minimum percentage of marks in qualifying examination shall not be below 45% of total marks in case of General category applicants, 42% of total marks in case of OBC and 40% of total marks in case of SC & ST applicants.

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ATTENDANCE :-

1. Every student shall attend not less than Seventy Five(75%) percent of the classes in each subject in each Semester.
2. Conduct and progress should be satisfactory during the Semester period.
3. Students who fail to satisfy the above requirements shall not be eligible to take the Semester Examination.

Duration of the Programme : B.A., LL.B., 5 Year Programme :

1. The duration of B.A.,LL.B., 5 Year integrated programme shall be five academic years consisting of Ten Semesters.
2. Each Academic Year shall be divided into two Semesters.
3. Each Semester shall consist of 18 weeks.
4. The subjects of concerned Semester is listed to these regulations.
5. Every student of B.A., LLB., 5 Year programme shall get 4 weeks of Internship (Training) at the end of every year and totally 20 weeks of internship during the entire 5 year programme.

PROGRAMME OF STUDY :-

The candidate admitted to the progrmme shall pursue the progrmme of study as prescribed by the KARNATAKA STATE LAW UNIVERSITY from time to time.

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DURATION OF THE PROGRAMME :- LL.B., 3 YEAR PROGRAMME :

1. LL.B./ 3 Year degree Programme shall be of Three Years duration spread over Six Semesters.
2. Each Academic year shall be divided into Two Semesters.
3. Each Semester shall consist of 18 weeks.
4. The subjects of concerned Semester is listed to these regulations.
5. Every student of LL.B. 3 Year programme should under go 4 weeks of inernship (Training) at the end of every year and totally 12 weeks of internship during the entire 3 year programme.

PROMOTION :-

1. No student shall be promoted to the next year of the programme unless he/she has passed in a minimum of one subject, in each semester of BA. LL.B., 5 Year Programme.
2. The above rule is not applicable in the case of LL.B., 3 Year Programme (carryover system is adopted)
3. Students are required to successfully complete the entire programme within Ten years from the date of admission to the programme in case of BA. LL.B., 5 Year Programme.
4. Students of LL.B. 3 year programme are required to successfully complete the entire course within six year from the date of admission to the programme in case of LL.B., 3 Year Programme.

AWARD OF THE DEGREE :-

1. A student shall be eligible for the award of the B.A., LL.B.,5 year degree after he/she has successfully completed all the prescribed courses in all the Semesters and has secured a minimum of 40% in the aggregate provided his/her character and conduct are found to be satisfactory during the programme (BA., LL.B., 5 Year).

2. A student shall be eligible for the award of the LL.B.,3 year Degree after he/she has successfully completed all the prescribed courses in all the semesters and has secured a minimum of 40% in the aggregate provided his or her character and conduct are found to be satisfactory during the course (LL.B., 3 Year).

AWARD OF CLASSES AND RANKS (FOR BA. LL.B., 5 Year & 3 Year)

1. The award of classes shall be as under.

70% and more - First Class with Distinction.

60% and above but less than 70% - First Class.

50% and above but less than 60% - Second Class.

40% and above but less than 50% - Pass Class.
2. The first 10 Ranks shall be declared by the KSLU in both the english and kannnada medium at the end of all Semesters examinations as per **the Karnataka State Law University** regulations.

PATTERN OF EXAMINATIONS

There shall be a Semester system of Examinations once in every six months, generally in the month of January and June of every year. The examination pattern is consisting with 20 marks for Internal Assessment and 80 marks for theoretical examinations. The Internal Assessment Examination includes 10 marks for Test, 5 marks for Assignment and 5 marks for Seminar at the college level and for remaining 80 marks theoretical examination to be conducted by the KSLU.
